AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for examination of applicant for driver's license.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section $1508(a)$ of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 1508. Examination of applicant for driver's license.
(a) General rule.--Every applicant for a driver's license shall be examined for the type or class of vehicles that the applicant desires to drive. The examination shall include a physical examination, a screening test of the applicant's eyesight and a test of the applicant's ability to read and understand official traffic-control devices, knowledge of safe driving practices and the traffic laws of this Commonwealth, and shall include an actual demonstration of ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the operation of a motor vehicle of the type or class of vehicles for which the applicant

desires a license to drive. All written and oral examinations
required pursuant to this section shall be administered only in
the English language. If the department finds it necessary to
further determine an applicant's fitness to operate a motor
vehicle safely upon the highways the department may require one
or more of the following types of examinations:
    (1) A vision examination by an optometrist or
    ophthalmologist.
    (2) A physical examination pursuant to section 1508.1
    (relating to physical examinations).
    (3) A mental examination.

    Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
