## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in minors, providing for the offense
- of selling or furnishing spray paint to minors.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6316.1. Selling or furnishing spray paint to minors.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits a summary offense if
- 10 he knowingly sells or furnishes or purchases with the intent to
- 11 sell or furnish spray paint to a person who is less than 18
- 12 years of age, except where the relationship of parent and child,
- 13 quardian and ward or adult instructor and pupil exists between
- 14 <u>such person and the person who is less than 18 years of age.</u>
- 15 (b) Penalty. -- A person who is convicted of violating
- 16 <u>subsection</u> (a) shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than
- 17 \$250 for the first violation and a fine of \$500 for each
- 18 subsequent violation.

- 1 (c) Definition. -- As used in this section, "spray paint"
- 2 <u>shall mean a sealed pressurized container that holds paint and</u>
- 3 <u>from which paint is released in a fine spray mist by depressing</u>
- 4 <u>a valve button.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
