AN ACT

1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for investigations and
3 enforcement.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1517(a.1)(2) of Title 4 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1517. Investigations and enforcement.

9 * * *

10 (a.1) Powers and duties of bureau.--The Bureau of
11 Investigations and Enforcement shall have the following powers
12 and duties:

13 * * *

14 (2) Investigate and review all applicants and
15 applications for a license, permit or registration. The
16 bureau shall be prohibited from disclosing any portion of a
17 background investigation report to any member prior to the

1 submission of the bureau's final background investigation
2 report relating to the applicant's suitability for licensure
3 to the board. The Office of Enforcement Counsel, on behalf of
4 the bureau, shall prepare the final background investigation
5 report for inclusion in a final report relating to the
6 applicant's suitability for licensure. Appended to each such
7 report shall be all information collected by the bureau that
8 relates to the applicant.

9 * * *

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
