1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	Amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the licensing of eligible organizations to conduct games of chance, for the licensing of persons to distribute games of chance, and for suspensions and revocations of licenses and permits; requiring records; providing for local referendum by electorate; and prescribing penalties," further providing for definitions; and providing for Major League Baseball or , National Hockey League OR NATIONAL BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION 50/50 raffle RAFFLES; AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR LICENSING OF ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATIONS TO CONDUCT GAMES OF CHANCE.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. The definition of "games of chance" in section
16	103 of the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), known as
17	the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, renumbered and
18	amended February $ frac{6}{2}$, 2012 (P.L.7, No.2), is amended and the

21	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

1 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 2 context clearly indicates otherwise:

3 <u>"50/50 drawing." A game in which a participant buys a ticket</u>
4 for a chance at a prize with the winner or winners determined by
5 a random drawing of a corresponding ticket. The prize paid to
6 the winner or winners is comprised of one-half of the proceeds
7 from the game and the remaining proceeds retained by the
8 eligible organization.

"Games of chance." Punchboards, daily drawings, weekly 10 drawings, 50/50 drawings, raffles, Major League Baseball or, 11 12 National Hockey League OR NATIONAL BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION 50/50 13 raffles, SELECTIVE RAFFLES and pull-tabs, as defined in this act, provided that no such game shall be played by or with the 14 15 assistance of any mechanical or electrical devices or media 16 other than a dispensing machine or passive selection device and further provided that the particular chance taken by any person 17 18 in any such game shall not be made contingent upon any other 19 occurrence or the winning of any other contest, but shall be 20 determined solely at the discretion of the purchaser. This 21 definition shall not be construed to authorize any other form of gambling currently prohibited under any provision of Title 18 of 22 23 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes (relating to crimes and 24 offenses) or authorized under 4 Pa.C.S. (relating to 25 amusements). Nothing in this act shall be construed to authorize 26 games commonly known as "slot machines" or "video poker." 27 * * *

17	REVENUE RECEIPTS SURPASS \$2,500 DURING THE PERIOD FOR

20	(A) WITHIN 180 DAYS OF SURPASSING THE SPECIFIED
