AN ACT

1 Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in ethics standards and financial
3 disclosure, further providing for statement of financial
4 interests.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1105(b)(6) and (7) of Title 65 of the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

9 § 1105. Statement of financial interests.

11 (b) Required information.--The statement shall include the
12 following information for the prior calendar year with regard to
13 the person required to file the statement:

14 * * *

15 (6) The name and address of the source and the amount of
16 any gift or gifts, not otherwise prohibited by this chapter,
17 valued in the aggregate at \$250 or more and the circumstances
18 of each gift. This paragraph shall not apply to a gift or
19 gifts received from a spouse, parent, parent by marriage,

1 sibling, child, grandchild, other family member or friend
2 when the circumstances make it clear that the motivation for
3 the action was a personal or family relationship. However,
4 for the purposes of this paragraph, the term "friend" shall
5 not include a registered lobbyist or an employee of a
6 registered lobbyist.

7 (7) The name and address of the source and the amount of
8 any payment for or reimbursement of actual expenses for
9 transportation and lodging or hospitality received in
10 connection with public office or employment, not otherwise
11 prohibited by this chapter, where such actual expenses for
12 transportation and lodging or hospitality exceed \$650 in an
13 aggregate amount per year. This paragraph shall not apply to
14 expenses reimbursed by a governmental body or to expenses
15 reimbursed by an organization or association of public
16 officials or employees of political subdivisions which the
17 public official or employee serves in an official capacity.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
