AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; 7 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 11 elections," further providing for requirements relating to voter identification. 12
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. Section 206 of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333,
- 16 No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, added March
- 17 14, 2012 (P.L.195, No.18), is amended to read:
- 18 Section 206. Requirements Relating to Voter
- 19 Identification.--(a) The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 20 prepare and disseminate information to the public regarding the

- 1 proof of identification requirements established under sections
- 2 1210 and 1302.
- 3 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510(b)
- 4 (relating to issuance and content of driver's license) to the
- 5 contrary, the Department of Transportation shall issue an
- 6 identification card described in 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510(b) at no cost
- 7 to any registered elector who has made application therefor and
- 8 has included with the completed application a statement signed
- 9 by the elector declaring under oath or affirmation that the
- 10 elector does not possess proof of identification as defined in
- 11 section 102(z.5)(2) and requires proof of identification for
- 12 voting purposes.
- 13 (c) The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall prepare the form
- 14 of the statement described in subsection (b) and shall
- 15 distribute the form to the counties and the Department of
- 16 Transportation. The Secretary of the Commonwealth, the Secretary
- 17 of Transportation and the county boards of election shall
- 18 disseminate information to the public regarding the availability
- 19 of identification cards under subsection (b).
- 20 (d) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 807 of the act
- 21 of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304, No.66), known as the Vital Statistics
- 22 Law of 1953, the Department of Health shall waive fees to obtain
- 23 birth certificates for individuals requiring the document to
- 24 <u>obtain a State-issued identification card. The Department of</u>
- 25 Health shall also reimburse citizens the cost of government fees
- 26 up to fifty dollars (\$50) for obtaining a birth certificate from
- 27 <u>other states for individuals requiring the document to obtain a</u>
- 28 State-issued identification card.
- 29 <u>(e) The State shall put no limitations on the use of photo</u>
- 30 identification cards obtained without cost for purposes of

- 1 <u>voting.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
