## AN ACT

- 1 Designating the bridge carrying Torresdale Avenue, State Route
- 2 1004, over the Pennypack Creek, in Philadelphia County, as
- 3 the Paul W. Kauffman Memorial Bridge.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Paul W. Kauffman Memorial Bridge.
- 7 (a) Declaration of policy. -- The General Assembly finds and
- 8 declares as follows:
- 9 (1) Paul W. Kauffman was a resident of Upper Holmesburg
- for 52 years along with his wife Lorraine.
- 11 (2) Mr. Kaufmann was the driving force behind an effort
- 12 to turn a vacant lot into the Trumbette Playground that now
- has three ball fields, a basketball court and climbing
- 14 equipment for children. Mr. Kauffmann maintained the park
- 15 every day by cleaning up waste and locking and unlocking the
- 16 gate.
- 17 (3) Mr. Kauffman was a community activist who became the
- 18 face of the Upper Holmesburg Civic Association after it was
- reformed in 2004. His involvement in the Upper Holmesburg

- 1 Civic Association led to involvement in other Northeastern
- 2 Philadelphia civic associations as well as the 8th Police
- 3 District Advisory Committee.
- 4 (4) Mr. Kauffmann also led Upper Holmesburg
- 5 beautification projects that included the planting of trees
- 6 and the installation of benches, banners and additional
- 7 lighting along Frankford Avenue.
- 8 (5) Mr. Kauffman served as a Democratic committeeman in
- 9 the 65th Ward and was a frequent sight at the offices of his
- 10 city and State representatives.
- 11 (6) Mr. Kauffmann passed away August 22, 2011.
- 12 (b) Designation. -- The bridge carrying Torresdale Avenue,
- 13 State Route 1004, over the Pennypack Creek in Philadelphia
- 14 County, is designated as the Paul W. Kauffman Memorial Bridge.
- 15 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 16 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 17 traffic in both directions.
- 18 Section 2. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
