AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for aggravated
- 3 assault.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2702(a)(2) and (3) of Title 18 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 2702. Aggravated assault.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of aggravated
- 10 assault if he:
- 11 * * *
- 12 (2) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
- 13 recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the
- officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in
- 15 subsection (c) or to an employee of an agency, company or
- other entity engaged in public transportation, while in the

- 1 performance of duty or to a child under six years of age;
- 2 (3) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly
- 3 causes bodily injury to any of the officers, agents,
- 4 employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), in
- 5 the performance of duty or to a child under six years of age;

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
