A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Pittsburgh Supercomputing Center on the 25th  
2 anniversary of its founding.

3 WHEREAS, The Pittsburgh Supercomputing Center is a joint  
4 effort of Carnegie Mellon University and the University of  
5 Pittsburgh, together with Westinghouse Electric Company, that  
6 fosters collaboration across university, industry and government  
7 organizations and is funded by Federal agencies with support  
8 from the Department of Community and Economic Development; and

9 WHEREAS, The National Science Board approved funding for the  
10 Pittsburgh Supercomputing Center on January 17, 1986; and

11 WHEREAS, The Pittsburgh Supercomputing Center is a national  
12 leader in enabling breakthroughs in science and engineering  
13 since 1986 by early adoption of the most advanced computing and  
14 communications technology available; and

15 WHEREAS, The Pittsburgh Supercomputing Center reinforces the  
16 reputation of this Commonwealth as a technological leader,  
17 enhancing the State's ability to attract new businesses; and

18 WHEREAS, On January 17, 2011, the Pittsburgh Supercomputing

1 Center marked its 25th anniversary; therefore be it  
2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate the  
3 Pittsburgh Supercomputing Center on the 25th anniversary of its  
4 founding.
