A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of March 2011 as "Medical Physicist Awareness and Appreciation Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Medical physicists calibrate, test and monitor the
- 4 radiation emission of equipment used in diagnostic radiological
- 5 physics, therapeutic radiological or radiation oncology physics,
- 6 medical nuclear physics and medical health physics; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The work of medical physicists is necessary and
- 8 integral to ensure the safe and effective use of radiation in a
- 9 medical context; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Patients and the general public are typically
- 11 unaware of the integral role medical physicists play in ensuring
- 12 that only safe and appropriate levels of radiation are applied
- 13 during a radiation-based medical treatment; and
- 14 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has an interest in recognizing and
- 15 promoting the safe application of medical physics by qualified

- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 3 month of March 2011 as "Medical Physicist Awareness and
- 4 Appreciation Month" in Pennsylvania.
