1 Recognizing the week beginning May 23, 2011, as "Small Business
2 Week" in Pennsylvania.

5 WHEREAS, The 234,540 small businesses in Pennsylvania produce
6 over \$77.4 billion in annual income, including benefits; and

8 are in small businesses; therefore be it
