## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating March 2012 as "American Red Cross Month" in
- 2 Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, On May 21, 1881, Clara Barton founded the American
- 4 Association of the Red Cross; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 1900, the Congress of the United States granted
- 6 the American Red Cross a charter, making the volunteer
- 7 organization responsible for providing services to members of
- 8 the armed forces of the United States and relief to disaster
- 9 victims domestically and abroad; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Today's American Red Cross is a humanitarian
- 11 organization led by volunteers that provides relief to victims

- 1 of disasters and helps people prevent, prepare for and respond
- 2 to emergencies; and
- 3 WHEREAS, For more than a century, the American Red Cross has
- 4 been at the forefront of helping Americans prevent, prepare for
- 5 and respond to large and small disasters; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Just as families and communities depend on the
- 7 American Red Cross in times of need, the American Red Cross
- 8 depends on the support of the American people to help sustain
- 9 the foundation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross sheltered more than 6,000
- 11 individuals and fed more than 250,000,000 Pennsylvanians during
- 12 Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee in August and September
- 13 of 2011; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Assistance to Commonwealth residents provided
- 15 upwards of \$3.4 million to get families and individuals back on
- 16 their feet; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In the 2011 fiscal year, volunteers and staff from
- 18 the American Red Cross responded to 2,971 disasters throughout
- 19 this Commonwealth, providing relief for more than 4,000
- 20 families; and
- 21 WHEREAS, More than 35,000 Pennsylvanians served as volunteers
- 22 for the American Red Cross, and as much as 3.2% of the residents
- 23 of Pennsylvania learned lifesaving skills while learning
- 24 Pennsylvania's disaster preparedness programs in 2011; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Residents of Pennsylvania donated hundreds of
- 26 thousands of units of blood to help save the lives of their
- 27 neighbors and provide for their needs; and
- 28 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross strives to prevent and
- 29 alleviate human suffering wherever it may be found, to protect
- 30 life and health and to ensure respect for each human being; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross makes no discrimination as to
- 2 nationality, race, religious beliefs, class or political
- 3 opinions; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Services provided by the American Red Cross promote
- 5 mutual understanding, friendship, cooperation and lasting peace
- 6 among all people; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross continues to play a valuable
- 8 role in catastrophic relief, humanitarianism and volunteerism
- 9 during the 21st century; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate March
- 11 2012 as "American Red Cross Month" in Pennsylvania; and be it
- 12 further
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 14 American Red Cross, its employees and its volunteers for their
- 15 dedication, service and sacrifice to the communities and
- 16 residents of this Commonwealth; and be it further
