A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of April 2012 as "Anti-Bullying Month" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Bullying is one of the most common forms of
4 violence, verbal and physical, in schools; and

5 WHEREAS, It is estimated that thousands of children miss
6 school every day due to fear of attack or intimidation by other
7 students; and

8 WHEREAS, Bullying is a destructive, antisocial behavior that
9 is contrary to the principles of democracy and decency on which
10 our nation and this Commonwealth were founded; therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare the month
12 of April 2012 as "Anti-Bullying Month" in Pennsylvania; and be
13 it further

14 RESOLVED, That all residents of this Commonwealth be

1 encouraged to combat bullying whenever and wherever such conduct
2 occurs.
