1 Honoring the life and service of Francis S. "Frank" Langianese,
2 Lewis Run Borough Council President, and extending
3 condolences to his family and friends.

4 WHEREAS, Lewis Run Borough Council President Francis S.
5 "Frank" Langianese, a longtime pillar of the Lewis Run
6 community, has passed away at 90 years of age; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese was in his 56th year serving as
8 borough council president, a job he dedicated his life to and
9 took very seriously according to those who knew him best; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese was born on December 10, 1921, in
11 Lewis Run, the son of the late Michael and Josephine Benedict
12 Langianese; and

13 WHEREAS, On June 1, 1946, Mr. Langianese married Esther M.
14 Doriguzzi, who preceded him in death on March 12, 2003; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese was a 1940 graduate of the St.
2 Bernard School, where he played for the school football team;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese was a United States Army Air Corps
5 veteran of World War II, having served in the European Theater;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese was a member of Our Mother of
8 Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Lewis Run, where he was on the
9 financial board; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese had also worked on the books for the
11 former Italian Mutual Aid Society; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese was a Grand Knight of the Knights of
13 Columbus #403 as well as their financial officer; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese played for and managed the Lewis Run
15 team in the McKean Elk baseball league and officiated high
16 school football games, retiring after 61 years as an umpire; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese considered it an honor working 24 of
18 the first 25 Don Raabe Big 30 Charities Classic games, and he
19 was instrumental in arranging and officiating crew for the first
20 game; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese is survived by one son, Rick
22 (Roxanne); three brothers, Matt Langianese, Sam (Florence)
23 Langianese and Mike Langianese, Jr.; one sister, Jeanne (Mike)
24 Senuta of Olean, New York; two grandsons, Jason (Ciss)
25 Langianese and Colton Langianese; one granddaughter, Daniella
26 (Rick) Griesbaum; three great-grandchildren, Brook, Colin and
27 Aisley; one sister-in-law, Betty Langianese and several nieces
28 and nephews; and

29 WHEREAS, In addition to his wife and parents, Mr. Langianese
30 was also preceded in death by one brother, Tony Langianese;
