12 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese was a Grand Knight of the Knights of 13 Columbus #403 as well as their financial officer; and 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese played for and managed the Lewis Run 15 team in the McKean Elk baseball league and officiated high 16 school football games, retiring after 61 years as an umpire; and 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Langianese considered it an honor working 24 of 18 the first 25 Don Raabe Big 30 Charities Classic games, and he 19 was instrumental in arranging and officiating crew for the first 20 game; and
