A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing July 2012 as "Take a Swing Against Breast Cancer
2 Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition presents
4 the Take a Swing Against Breast Cancer project and will take
5 part in a series of home run derby events honoring one of
6 America's favorite pastimes while raising awareness of breast
7 cancer and for breast cancer education, outreach and advocacy
8 throughout this Commonwealth; and

9 WHEREAS, This unique community event unites eight minor
10 league ballparks from all across this Commonwealth with the goal
11 of heightening awareness of the disease currently affecting
12 103,000 Pennsylvania women, with 9,000 more being diagnosed each

2 WHEREAS, By partnering with minor league ballparks in all
3 corners of the State, from the Harrisburg Senators on July 10th
4 and the York Revolution on July 12th to the Lancaster
5 Barnstormers on July 14th and to the Reading Phillies on July
6 17th; from the Erie SeaWolves on July 19th and the Washington
7 Wild Things on July 20th to the Williamsport Crosscutters on
8 July 24th and to the Altoona Curve on July 25th, we can
9 encourage families from diverse interests to come together for
10 fun activities to raise money for an important cause; therefore
