18	(a) ProhibitionThe Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby	
19	elects pursuant to the authority granted the states under	
20	section 1303(a) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care	
21	<u>Act (Public Law 111-148, 42 U.S.C. § 18023(b)) to prohibit</u>	
22	certain abortion coverage in qualified health plans offered	
23	through the health insurance exchange under subsection (b).	
24	(b) Included coverage prohibitionNo qualified health plan	
25	offered in this Commonwealth through the health insurance	
26	exchange shall include coverage for the performance of any	
27	abortion unless the reason the abortion is performed is one for	
28	which the expenditure of public funds would be permitted under	
29	18 Pa.C.S. § 3215(c) (relating to publicly owned facilities;	
30	public officials and public funds) and the applicable reports	
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1	<u>required under 18 Pa.C.S. § 3215(c) are made.</u>
2	(c) Excluded coverage prohibitedNo qualified health plan
3	offered in this Commonwealth through a health insurance exchange
4	shall exclude coverage for treatment of any post-abortion
5	complication.
6	(d) OptionNothing in this section shall prohibit an
7	individual from purchasing optional supplemental abortion
8	coverage provided the individual pays a separate premium for the
9	coverage and obtains the coverage outside of the health
10	insurance exchange.

11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
