- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 - Statutes, prohibiting obscene displays on and in motor
- 3 vehicles.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 4538. Obscene displays on and in motor vehicles.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- No owner of a motor vehicle shall display
- 10 on or in the motor vehicle a motion picture, bumper sticker,
- 11 window sign or other marking that is obscene or depicts sexual
- 12 conduct and that may be visible to the driver of another motor
- 13 vehicle.
- 14 (b) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 15 <u>summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay</u>
- 16 a fine of not less than \$100.
- 17 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 18 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

- 1 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 2 "Obscene." As defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 5903(b) (relating to
- 3 <u>obscene and other sexual materials and performances</u>).
- 4 "Sexual conduct." As defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 5903(b).
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
