## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 commissions shall be determined," in Commonwealth agency 20 fees, further providing for Department of State; and 21 providing for a uniform code. 22 23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 24 hereby enacts as follows: 25 Section 1. Within 30 days of the effective date of this 14 section, the Department of State shall make available and 15 publish in the Pennsylvania Bulletin a uniform form to request 16 for the legalization of documents. The form shall include all of 17 the following: 18 (1)Name of requester. 19 (2) Organization. 20 (3) Address. 21 (4)Telephone number. 22 (5) Country for which documents are being prepared. 23 (6) Number of documents to be certified. 24 Whether the request is for legalization of documents 25 for an international adoption proceeding. 26 Signature of requester. (8)

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Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
