## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the first, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, 3 revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes by counties, 5 including authorizing imposition of an excise tax on the 7 rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and providing for regional renaissance initiatives," in special 8 powers and duties of counties, further providing for flags to 9 decorate graves. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 1922(d) of the act of August 9, 1955 14 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, amended June 12, 15 1986 (P.L.253, No.66), is amended to read: 16 Section 1922. Flags to Decorate Graves. -- \* \* 17 The authorities in charge of any cemetery are authorized to remove such flags when the same become unsightly or 18 19 weatherworn at any time not before the first working day after 20 Independence Day of each year: Provided, however, That the flag

- 2 time unless the flag holders are immediately replaced with new

- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
