- Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled 2 "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics; 3 conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and 4 Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug, 5 Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring 7 registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the 8 revocation or suspension of certain licenses and 9 registrations; and repealing an act," providing for the definitions of "clinical trial" and "pharmaceutical drug." 10 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1.
