6	Section 1. Section 6106(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 6106. Firearms not to be carried without a license.
9	(a) Offense defined
10	(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), any person who
11	carries a firearm in any vehicle or any person who carries a
12	firearm concealed on or about his person, except in his place
13	of abode or fixed place of business, without a valid and
14	lawfully issued license under this chapter commits a felony
15	of the third degree[.] <u>and shall, upon conviction, serve a</u>
16	mandatory minimum one-year sentence.
17	(2) A person who is otherwise eligible to possess a

valid license under this chapter but carries a firearm in any

1 vehicle or any person who carries a firearm concealed on or 2 about his person, except in his place of abode or fixed place of business, without a valid and lawfully issued license and 3 4 has not committed any other criminal violation commits a misdemeanor of the first degree[.] and shall, upon 5 conviction, serve a mandatory minimum one-year sentence. 6 * * * 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 8
