AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112), 1 entitled "An act relating to the right to practice medicine 2 and surgery and the right to practice medically related acts; 3 reestablishing the State Board of Medical Education and Licensure as the State Board of Medicine and providing for its composition, powers and duties; providing for the issuance of licenses and certificates and the suspension and 7 revocation of licenses and certificates; providing penalties; and making repeals," further providing for unauthorized 9 practice of medicine and surgery. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 10 of the act act of December 20, 1985 14 (P.L.457, No.112), known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, is 15 amended to read: 16 Section 10. Unauthorized practice of medicine and surgery. 17 (a) Offense defined. -- No person other than a medical doctor 18 shall engage in any of the following conduct except as 19 authorized or exempted in this act:
- 20 (1) Practice medicine and surgery.
- 21 (2) Purport to practice medicine and surgery.

- 1 (3) Hold forth as authorized to practice medicine and
- 2 surgery through use of a title, including, but not
- 3 necessarily limited to, medical doctor, doctor of medicine,
- 4 doctor of medicine and surgery, doctor of a designated
- 5 disease, physician, physician of a designated disease, or any
- 6 abbreviation for the foregoing.
- 7 (4) Otherwise hold forth as authorized to practice
- 8 medicine and surgery.
- 9 (b) Penalty for unauthorized practice. -- Any person who
- 10 violates subsection (a) commits a misdemeanor of the first
- 11 <u>degree and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than</u>
- 12 \$5,000 nor more than \$15,000 or to imprisonment for not more
- 13 than five years, or both, for the first violation. On the second
- 14 and each subsequent conviction, the person shall be sentenced to
- 15 pay a fine of not less than \$10,000 nor more than \$25,000 or to
- 16 imprisonment for not less than six months nor more than five
- 17 years, or both.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
