- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 problem-solving courts.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 916 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 916. Problem-solving courts.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (d) Imposition of surcharge. -- A defendant convicted of an
- 11 offense in a problem-solving court established in the First
- 12 Judicial District may be ordered by that particular problem-
- 13 solving court to pay a surcharge of \$25, which shall be
- 14 collected in the same manner as other court costs. In addition
- 15 to any grants or other money that may become available through
- 16 public or private sources, the money collected through this
- 17 <u>surcharge shall be used by the county to fund the problem-</u>
- 18 solving court or courts and the related treatment services.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
