AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from a restricted revenue account within
2 the General Fund and from Federal augmentation funds to the
3 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission; and providing for the
4 additional appropriation of Federal funds from the General
5 Fund to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for the
6 fiscal year July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
10 necessary, are specifically appropriated from the restricted
11 revenue account within the General Fund and from Federal
12 augmentation funds to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission
13 to provide for the operation of the commission for the fiscal
14 year July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012, for the purposes and in the
15 amounts shown:

For the salaries, wages and all
necessary expenses for the proper
operation and administration of the
Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission,

1 including the chairman and
2 commissioners and the Bureau of Safety
3 and Enforcement.

4 State appropriation..... 58,898,000

5 The following Federal augmentation
6 amounts, or as much thereof as may be
7 necessary, are specifically
8 appropriated to supplement the sum
9 authorized to be billed to utilities
10 for the operation of the commission:

11 (1) "Natural Gas Pipeline
12 Safety" - To enforce the regulations
13 of the Natural Gas Pipeline Safety
14 Act.

15 Federal appropriation..... 1,501,000

16 (2) "Motor Carrier Safety."

17 Federal appropriation..... 1,888,000

18 (3) "ARRA - Electric Regulatory
19 Assistance."

20 Federal appropriation..... 511,000

21 Any Federal funds which the
22 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission
23 receives pursuant to these
24 appropriations shall not be reimbursed
25 to any utility.

26 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, or
27 immediately, whichever is later.
