AN ACT

Providing for the adoption of capital projects related to the repair, rehabilitation or replacement of highway bridges and 3 for the adoption of specific flood mitigation projects or disaster assistance projects to be financed from debt incurred under clause (1) of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 CHAPTER 1 10 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS Section 101. Short title. 11 12 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Disaster 13 Relief Act of 2011. 14 CHAPTER 3 15 BRIDGES 16 Section 301. - 3 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

- 6 "Capital project." A capital project as defined in section
- 7 302 of the act of February 9, 1999 (P.L.1, No.1), known as the
- 8 Capital Facilities Debt Enabling Act, and shall include county
- 9 or municipal bridge rehabilitation, replacement or improvement
- 10 projects as set forth in this chapter.
- 11 "Department." The Department of Transportation of the
- 12 Commonwealth.
- "Secretary." The Secretary of Transportation of the
- 14 Commonwealth.
- 15 Section 303. Total authorization for bridge projects.
- 16 The total authorization for the projects itemized pursuant to
- 17 this chapter and to be financed from debt incurred under clause
- 18 (1) of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the
- 19 Constitution of Pennsylvania is \$75,000,000.
- 20 Section 304. Itemization of bridge projects.
- 21 The individual capital projects in the category of highway
- 22 projects to be constructed by the department, its successors or
- 23 assigns, and to be financed from debt incurred under clause (1)
- 24 of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the
- 25 Constitution of Pennsylvania are hereby itemized, together with
- 26 their respective estimated financial costs, in the following

- 1 Section 372. Estimated useful life of projects.
- 2 The General Assembly states the estimated useful life of the
- 3 projects itemized in this chapter is 30 years.
- 4 Section 373. Federal funds.
- 5 All moneys received from the Federal Government for the
- 6 highway and highway bridge projects specifically itemized in
- 7 this chapter are also hereby appropriated for those projects.
- 8 Section 374. Construction.
- 9 (a) Utilization of Federal funds. -- Amounts contained in this
- 10 chapter for any project shall not supplant or replace any
- 11 Federal funds authorized by any Federal law or regulation.
- 12 Funding from this chapter for any project is available only to
- 13 the extent that Federal funds are not available for such
- 14 project.
- 15 (b) Continuity with bridge supplementals. -- The provisions of
- 16 this chapter shall be construed unless specifically provided
- 17 otherwise as a supplement to the act of December 8, 1982
- 18 (P.L.848, No.235), known as the Highway-Railroad and Highway
- 19 Bridge Capital Budget Act for 1982-1983.
- 20 Section 375. Allocation of funds.
- 21 Whenever the Department of Transportation determines that the
- 22 full estimated financial costs of the projects itemized in this
- 23 chapter are not necessary for the proper design, acquisition or
- 24 construction of such project, the excess funds no longer
- 25 required may be allocated by the department to increase the
- 26 estimated costs of any one or more of the projects specifically
- 27 itemized in a capital budget.
- 28 CHAPTER 5
- 29 RAILROAD DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROJECTS
- 30 Section 501. Short title of chapter.

- 1 This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the Railroad
- 2 Disaster Assistance Projects Itemization Act of 2011.
- 3 Section 502. Definitions.
- 4 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 5 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 6 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 7 "Disaster." The period of time in calendar year 2011
- 8 relating to Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee that was the
- 9 subject of a presidential declaration of an emergency under The
- 10 Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
- 11 (Public Law 93-288, 88 Stat. 143).
- 12 Section 503. Total authorization.
- 13 The total authorization for disaster assistance projects to
- 14 be financed in part with grants as itemized in this chapter is
- 15 \$2,000,000.
- 16 Section 504. Itemization of disaster mitigation or assistance
- 17 projects.
- 18 The individual disaster mitigation or assistance projects to
- 19 be financed from current revenues or debt are hereby itemized,
- 20 together with their respective estimated financial costs, as
- 21 follows:
- Department of Transportation \$2,000,000
- 23 (1) Lycoming Valley Railroad \$1,000,000
- 24 Section 505. Funds.
- The projects itemized in this chapter shall be funded from
- 26 debt incurred under the provisions of clause (1) of subsection
- 27 (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution of
- 28 Pennsylvania.
- 29 Section 506. Federal funds.
- 30 All moneys received from the Federal Government for the

- 1 projects specifically itemized in this chapter are also hereby
- 2 appropriated for those projects.
- 3 Section 507. Construction.
- 4 Amounts contained in this chapter for any project shall not
- 5 supplant or replace any Federal funds authorized by any Federal
- 6 law or regulation. Funding from this chapter for any project is
- 7 available only to the extent that Federal funds are not
- 8 available for such project.
- 9 CHAPTER 7
- 10 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS
- 11 Section 701. Constitutional construction.
- 12 The provisions of this act shall be severable and, if any of
- 13 the provisions of this act shall be held unconstitutional, such
- 14 decisions shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining
- 15 provisions of this act. It is hereby declared as the legislative
- 16 intent that this act would have been adopted had such
- 17 unconstitutional provisions not been included in this act.
- 18 Section 702. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect immediately.
