AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
 5 laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and  
 6 between school districts, further providing for extraordinary  
 7 special education program expenses.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
 9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 2509.8 of the act of March 10, 1949  
 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is  
 12 amended by adding a subsection to read:

13 Section 2509.8. Extraordinary Special Education Program  
 14 Expenses.--\* \* \*

15 (f) For the 2012-2013 school year and each school year  
 16 thereafter, funds from the set-aside contained in subsection (e)  
 17 shall be allocated to each approved private school with a day  
 18 tuition rate determined to be less than thirty-two thousand  
 19 dollars (\$32,000) during the 2010-2011 school year. For each  
 20 such approved school the allocation shall be determined by  
 21 subtracting the approved private school's 2010-2011 school year

1 day tuition rate from thirty-eight thousand three hundred five  
2 dollars (\$38,305) and multiplying the result by the number of  
3 approved students enrolled in the approved private school during  
4 the 2010-2011 school year.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012, or  
6 immediately, whichever is later.
