AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for vehicles exempt from
3 registration and for persons exempt from licensing.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Sections 1302 and 1502 of Title 75 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding
8 paragraphs to read:

9 § 1302. Vehicles exempt from registration.

10 The following types of vehicles are exempt from registration:

11 * * *

12 (2.3) Any implement of husbandry, trailer or semitrailer
13 used exclusively for agricultural operations and only
14 infrequently operated upon highways. Vehicles exempt from
15 registration under this paragraph shall be used exclusively
16 upon a farm or farms owned or operated by the owner of the

1 vehicle or upon highways between the farm or farms and a
2 school that is hosting an annual agricultural-related
3 educational event for the purpose of participating in that
4 event, if the distance between the farm or farms and the site
5 of the event does not exceed 25 miles.

6 * * *

7 § 1502. Persons exempt from licensing.

8 The following persons are not required to obtain a driver's
9 license under this chapter:

10 * * *

11 (6) Any person 14 years of age or older may operate an
12 implement of husbandry not to exceed 11 feet in width on a
13 roadway for the purpose of driving that implement between
14 sunrise and sunset to an annual agricultural-related
15 educational event hosted by a school, provided that the
16 distance between the person's residence and the site of the
17 event does not exceed 25 miles.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
