Sentencing procedure for murder of the first degree. 9 10 (d) Aggravating circumstances. -- Aggravating circumstances shall be limited to the following: 11 * * * 12 13 (19) The defendant perpetrated a sexually violent 14 offense as defined in section 9792 (relating to definitions) 15 against the victim and, at the time of the killing, the 16 defendant was required to register pursuant to Subchapter H

- 1 <u>(relating to registration of sexual offenders).</u>
- 2 (20) The victim was over 60 years of age or the victim
- 3 was particularly vulnerable due to old age, infirmity or
- 4 <u>disability.</u>

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
