AN ACT

- Amending the act of January 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119, No.787), entitled, as amended, "An act to provide for the better 2 protection of the health, general welfare and property of the people of the Commonwealth by the control, abatement, 3 4 reduction and prevention of the pollution of the air by 5 smokes, dusts, fumes, gases, odors, mists, vapors, pollens 7 and similar matter, or any combination thereof; imposing certain powers and duties on the Department of Environmental 8 Resources, the Environmental Quality Board and the 9 Environmental Hearing Board; establishing procedures for the 10 protection of health and public safety during emergency 11 conditions; creating a stationary air contamination source 12 13 permit system; providing additional remedies for abating air pollution; reserving powers to local political subdivisions, 14 and defining the relationship between this act and the 15 ordinances, resolutions and regulations of counties, cities, 16 boroughs, towns and townships; imposing penalties for 17 violation of this act; and providing for the power to enjoin 18 violations of this act; and conferring upon persons aggrieved 19 certain rights and remedies," providing for the Clean 20 21 Vehicles Program.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. The act of January 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119,
- 25 No.787), known as the Air Pollution Control Act, is amended by

- 1 adding a section to read:
- 2 <u>Section 6.8. Clean Vehicles Program. -- In addition to the</u>
- 3 exceptions to the adoption, incorporation and application by the
- 4 <u>Clean Vehicles Program of the provisions of the California Low</u>
- 5 Emission Vehicle Program, Title 13 CCR, Division 3, Chapters 1
- 6 and 2, contained under 25 Pa. Code § 126.411(b) (relating to
- 7 general requirements), the provisions of Title 13 CCR, Division
- 8 3, Chapter 1, § 2030 (relating to liquefied petroleum gas or
- 9 <u>natural gas retrofit systems</u>) shall also be excepted.
- 10 Section 2. The provisions of 25 Pa. Code § 126.411(b) are
- 11 abrogated to the extent that they are inconsistent with the
- 12 addition of section 6.8 of the act.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
