## AN ACT

11	Section 1. Section 11 of the act of December 19, 1990
12	(P.L.1200, No.202), known as the Solicitation of Funds for
13	Charitable Purposes Act, is amended to read:

15	(a) Status and accessExcept as otherwise provided in
16	section 12, registration statements and applications, reports,

(b) Duty of secretary. -- The secretary shall develop an\_ 10

electronic filing system for all documents and information 11

12 required to be filed with the department under this act. The

13 system shall be operational no later than January 1, 2015.

17 (a) Establishment.--The Solicitation of Funds for Charitable

18 Purposes Account is established as a restricted account within

19 the General Fund.

20 (b) Purpose.--The purpose of the account is to fund the

21 regulatory actions under this act.

11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
