## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for suspension of operating privilege for failure to respond to citation. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1533(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended October 8, 2012 (P.L.1193, 7 No.146), is amended to read: 8 § 1533. Suspension of operating privilege for failure to 10 respond to citation. 11 Violations within Commonwealth. -- The department shall suspend the operating privilege of any person who has [failed] 12 done any of the following: 13 14 (1) Failed to respond to a citation or summons to appear 15 before an issuing authority or a court of competent 16 jurisdiction of this Commonwealth for: 17 (i) any violation of this title, other than 18 parking[,]; or [who has failed]

- 1 (ii) any violation of the act of March 10, 1949
- 2 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949.
- 3 (2) Failed to pay any fine, costs or restitution imposed
- 4 by an issuing authority or such courts for violation [of this
- 5 title, other than parking] <u>under paragraph (1)(i)</u>, upon being
- 6 duly notified by an issuing authority or a court of this
- 7 Commonwealth.

- 9 Section 2. The amendment of 75 Pa.C.S. § 1533(a) shall apply
- 10 to failures which occur on or after the effective date of this
- 11 section.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
