AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for suspension of operating
3 privilege for failure to respond to citation.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1533(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes, amended October 8, 2012 (P.L.1193,
8 No.146), is amended to read:

9 § 1533. Suspension of operating privilege for failure to
10 respond to citation.

11 (a) Violations within Commonwealth.--The department shall
12 suspend the operating privilege of any person who has [failed]
13 done any of the following:

14 (1) Failed to respond to a citation or summons to appear
15 before an issuing authority or a court of competent
16 jurisdiction of this Commonwealth for:

17 (i) any violation of this title, other than
18 parking[,]; or [who has failed]

1 (ii) any violation of the act of March 10, 1949
2 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949.
3 (2) Failed to pay any fine, costs or restitution imposed
4 by an issuing authority or such courts for violation [of this
5 title, other than parking] under paragraph (1)(i), upon being
6 duly notified by an issuing authority or a court of this
7 Commonwealth.

9 Section 2. The amendment of 75 Pa.C.S. § 1533(a) shall apply
10 to failures which occur on or after the effective date of this
11 section.

12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
