Section 6351(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 7 8 § 6351. Disposition of dependent child. General rule. -- If the child is found to be a dependent child the court may make any of the following orders of 10 disposition best suited to the safety, protection and physical, 11 mental, and moral welfare of the child: 12 13 14 (2.2) If the court determines that temporary or 15 permanent physical and legal custody shall be given to an individual or entity other than a child's parents, quardian 16

or other custodian, a grandparent who wishes to be given
