AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of
3 identity theft.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 4120(c)(2) of Title 18 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 4120. Identity theft.

10 (c) Grading.--The offenses shall be graded as follows:

11 * * *

12 (2) When a person commits an offense under subsection

13 (a) and the victim of the offense is 60 years of age or older

14 [or] a care-dependent person as defined in section 2713

15 (relating to neglect of care-dependent person) or an

16 individual under 18 years of age, the grading of the offense

17 shall be one grade higher than specified in paragraph (1).

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
