AN ACT

- Amending the act of October 9, 2008 (P.L.1408, No.113), entitled
 "An act requiring scrap processors and recycling facility
 operators to collect certain information relating to the
- purchase of scrap material; requiring commercial accounts; and restricting scrap processors and recycling facility
- operators from purchasing certain materials," further
- 7 providing for penalties.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 7 of the act of October 9, 2008
- 11 (P.L.1408, No.113), known as the Scrap Material Theft Prevention
- 12 Act, is amended to read:
- 13 Section 7. Penalties.
- 14 A scrap processor and recycling facility operator who
- 15 violates this act commits a [summary offense and shall, upon
- 16 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of up to \$2,500]
- 17 <u>misdemeanor of the third degree and upon conviction shall be</u>
- 18 sentenced to pay a fine of up to \$5,000. A second or subsequent
- 19 violation shall be classified as a misdemeanor of the [third]
- 20 second degree and, upon conviction, the violator shall be

- 1 sentenced to pay a fine of up to \$10,000.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
