AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for organization of commission.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 301(a) and (c) of Title 30 of the
- 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended November 1, 2012
- 7 $\frac{(P.L.1716, No.211)}{}$ are amended to read:
- 8 § 301. Organization of commission.
- 9 (a) Composition. -- The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission
- 10 is continued as an independent administrative commission and
- 11 shall consist of ten competent citizens of this Commonwealth who
- 12 shall be appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and
- 13 consent of a majority of the members elected to the Senate for
- 14 terms of [eight] four years and until their successors are
- 15 appointed and qualified.

- 17 (c) Terms of office and compensation. -- The members shall

- 1 hold office for terms of [eight] four years and until a
- 2 successor is appointed and qualified. [A member appointed to
- 3 fill a vacancy for a period of four years or less may be
- 4 eligible for appointment to a full eight-year term.] A member <--

- 5 who serves [a full eight-year term or fills a vacancy for a
- 6 period of more than four years] THREE CONSECUTIVE TERMS shall <--
- 7 not be eligible for reappointment to the commission. [until a <--
- 8 period of eight years expires.] The members shall receive no
- 9 compensation for their services but may be reimbursed for travel
- 10 expenses. When performing any function on behalf of the
- 11 commission or acting within the scope of their official duties,
- 12 members of the commission shall be authorized to operate
- 13 Commonwealth vehicles and watercraft and shall be treated as
- 14 employees of the Commonwealth for the purposes of automotive and
- 15 general liability and the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338),
- 16 known as the Workers' Compensation Act.

- 18 Section 2. The following shall apply:
- (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the
- amendment of 30 Pa.C.S. § 301(a) and (c) shall apply to
- 21 members of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission who are
- appointed on or after the effective date of this section.
- 23 (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), a member of the
- 24 Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission who serves a full-
- 25 eight-year term or fills a vacancy for a period of more than
- 26 four years shall be eligible for reappointment to the
- 27 commission at any time.
- 28 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
