Section 9718(a)(2) of Title 42 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 9718. Sentences for offenses against infant persons. 8 9 (a) Mandatory sentence. --\* \* \* 10 11 (2) A person convicted of the following offenses when 12 the victim is less than 13 years of age shall be sentenced to 13 a mandatory term of imprisonment as follows: 14 18 Pa.C.S. § 2702(a)(1) - not less than five years. 15 18 Pa.C.S. § 2705 (relating to recklessly endangering another person) when, at the time of the offense, the 16 defendant is providing "child day care," as defined in 17 section 1001 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), 18
