- 1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in emergency telephone service,
- providing for prohibited release of information.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 5399. Prohibited release of information.
- 9 (a) Prohibition. -- Notwithstanding any other law, in a
- 10 response to a request for a record under section 708(b)(18) of <--
- 11 the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-
- 12 to-Know Law, a PSAP may not release a PUBLIC record or part of a <--
- 13 PUBLIC record containing identifying information related to an <--
- 14 <u>individual calling a 911 center unless a court of competent</u> <--
- 15 jurisdiction determines that the public interest in disclosure
- 16 outweighs the interest in nondisclosure.

- 1 (b) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term
- 2 "identifying information" includes name, telephone number,
- 3 <u>address and location</u>.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
