AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge that carries State Route 153 over the
2 Bennett Branch in Huston Township, Clearfield County, as the
3 Huston Township Veterans Memorial Bridge; AND DESIGNATING <--
4 U.S. ROUTE 219 IN JOHNSONBURG BOROUGH, ELK COUNTY, FROM THE
5 INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 1009, CENTER STREET, STARTING AT
6 ROADWAY SEGMENT 0502 OFFSET 0000 TO THE INTERSECTION OF STATE
7 ROUTE 1009, CENTER STREET, ENDING AT ROADWAY SEGMENT 0522
8 OFFSET 1159, AS THE VETERANS OF JOHNSONBURG BYPASS.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Huston Township Veterans Memorial Bridge.

12 (a) Findings.--

13 (1) Huston Township, Clearfield County, has been home to
14 many valiant military veterans who have given their lives in
15 defense of the United States.

16 (2) The elected Board of Supervisors of Huston Township
17 has endorsed designating this bridge in honor of those
18 township residents who have made the ultimate sacrifice for

1 our nation over the years.

2 (b) Designation.--The bridge that carries State Route 153
3 over the Bennett Branch in Huston Township, Clearfield County,
4 is hereby designated as the Huston Township Veterans Memorial
5 Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

9 SECTION 2. VETERANS OF JOHNSONBURG BYPASS. <--

10 (A) FINDINGS.--THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT
11 THE BOROUGH OF JOHNSONBURG HAS BEEN HOME THROUGH THE YEARS TO
12 VETERANS, BOTH LIVING AND DECEASED, WHO HAVE SERVED OUR NATION
13 VALIANTLY.

14 (B) DESIGNATION.--U.S. ROUTE 219 IN JOHNSONBURG BOROUGH, ELK
15 COUNTY, FROM THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 1009, CENTER
16 STREET, STARTING AT ROADWAY SEGMENT 0502 OFFSET 0000 TO THE
17 INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 1009, CENTER STREET, ENDING AT
18 ROADWAY SEGMENT 0522 OFFSET 1159, IS HEREBY DESIGNATED AS THE
19 VETERANS OF JOHNSONBURG BYPASS.

20 (C) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
21 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS DISPLAYING THE NAME OF THE HIGHWAY TO
22 TRAFFIC IN BOTH DIRECTIONS.

23 Section 2 3. Effective date. <--

24 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
