AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the
3 offenses of harassment, stalking and threat to use weapons of
4 mass destruction.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 2709(e), 2709.1(e) and 2715(c.2) of
8 Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are repealed:
9 § 2709. Harassment.
