AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of S.R. 58001, known as Elk  
2 Run Road, over the Pine Creek, Gaines Township, Tioga County  
3 as the SFC William Boyle Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. SFC William Boyle Memorial Bridge.

7 (a) Findings.--

8 (1) SFC William Boyle, a resident of Watrous, attended  
9 Galeton High School, and served in the United States Army as  
10 an E7 with the MACV-SOG, 5th Special Forces Group in Vietnam.

11 (2) While bravely serving his country, SFC William Boyle  
12 was killed on February 28, 1970, when an enemy rocket hit his  
13 helicopter causing an explosion and a subsequent fire.

14 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on S.R. 58001, known as  
15 Elk Run Road, Gaines Township, Tioga County over the Pine Creek  
16 is hereby designated the SFC William Boyle Memorial Bridge.

1       (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
2 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to  
3 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

4 Section 2. Effective date.

5       This act shall take effect in 60 days.
