AN ACT

1 Designating the traffic circle on State Route 116 at Hanover
2 Road and Roth's Church Road in Spring Grove, York County, as
3 the Officer David D. Tome Memorial Circle.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Officer David D. Tome Memorial Circle.

7 (a) Findings.--

8 (1) Police officer David D. Tome was killed in the line
9 of duty on Tuesday, October 21, 2008, in Franklin Township,
10 York County, while serving as a member of the Northern York
11 County Regional Police Department. He was 31 years of age.

12 (2) Officer Tome left behind his wife of seven years,
13 Dody, and two children, Elijah and Joslyn Tome.

14 (3) Officer Tome was a native of York and a 1996
15 graduate of Spring Grove High School. He graduated in 2003
16 from Harrisburg Area Community College's 83rd Police Academy.

1 (4) Officer Tome served five years with the Northern
2 York County Regional Police Department.

3 (b) Designation.--The traffic circle located on State Route
4 116 at Hanover Road and Roth's Church Road in Spring Grove, York
5 County, is hereby designated the Officer David D. Tome Memorial
6 Circle.

7 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
8 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the traffic
9 circle to approaching traffic.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
