## AN ACT

- Amending the act of October 24, 2012 (P.L.1209, No.151),
  entitled "An act regulating child labor; conferring powers
  and duties on the Department of Labor and Industry and the
  Department of Education; imposing penalties; and making a
  repeal," further providing for definitions and for
  occupations and establishment.

  The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
  hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of October 24, 2012
- 10 (P.L.1209, No.151), known as the Child Labor Act, is amended by

- 13 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

- 17 <u>"Youth sports official." A minor who enforces the rules and</u>
- 18 supervises the participants of a youth sporting event,
- 19 <u>including</u>, but not limited to, an umpire or referee.

- 5 (d) Occupations for minors less than 14 years of age.--An
- 6 individual less than 14 years of age may be employed as follows:

- 8 (3) An individual who is at least 12 years of age may be
- 9 <u>employed as a youth sports official.</u>
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
