AN ACT

1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further defining "marriage"; and
3 repealing and adding provisions relating to same-sex
4 marriage.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. The definition of "marriage" in section 1102 of
8 Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to
9 read:

10 § 1102. Definitions.

11 The following words and phrases when used in this part shall
12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
13 context clearly indicates otherwise:

14 * * *

15 "Marriage." A civil contract [by which one man and one woman
16 take each other for husband and wife] between two people who
17 enter into matrimony.

18 * * *

1 Section 2. Section 1704 of Title 23 is repealed:

2 [§ 1704. Marriage between persons of the same sex.

3 It is hereby declared to be the strong and longstanding
4 public policy of this Commonwealth that marriage shall be
5 between one man and one woman. A marriage between persons of the
6 same sex which was entered into in another state or foreign
7 jurisdiction, even if valid where entered into, shall be void in
8 this Commonwealth.]

9 Section 3. Title 23 is amended by adding a section to read:

10 § 1704.1. Same-sex marriages.

11 (a) Construction.--Nothing in this title may be construed to
12 compel a religious sect to perform same-sex marriages.

13 (b) Marriages outside Commonwealth.--Marriages performed
14 legally outside this Commonwealth and outside this country shall
15 be recognized by the Commonwealth.

16 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
