## AN ACT

Designating Whitaker Avenue from its intersection with Roosevelt Boulevard in Philadelphia City, Philadelphia County, to the 2 point where it meets East Erie Avenue in Philadelphia City, 3 Philadelphia County, as the 65th Infantry "Borinqueneers" 5 Avenue. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. 65th Infantry "Boringueneers" Avenue. 8 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as follows: 10 11 The 65th Infantry Regiment is a Puerto Rican 12 regiment of the United States Army. The 65th Infantry 13 Regiment participated in World War I, World War II and the 14 Korean War. 15 "The Borinqueneers" is a nickname for the 65th 16 Infantry Regiment of the 3rd Division in the United States Army, an all-volunteer Puerto Rican unit. It was derived from 17 the name Boringuen meaning "land of the brave lord." It has

- also been interpreted as "land of the pure."
- 2 (3) Over 62,000 Puerto Ricans joined the military during
- 3 World War II and over 43,000 Puerto Ricans served in the
- 4 Korean War. While in Korea, the Borinqueneers served in nine
- 5 separate military campaigns, with hundreds of men giving
- 6 their lives to serve their country.
- 7 (4) The Regiment won four Distinguished Service Crosses
- 8 and 125 Silver Stars and was awarded the Presidential Unit
- 9 Citation and the Greek Gold Metal for Bravery for its
- 10 service.
- 11 (b) Designation. -- Whitaker Avenue from its intersection with
- 12 Roosevelt Boulevard in Philadelphia City, Philadelphia County,
- 13 to the point where it meets East Erie Avenue in Philadelphia
- 14 City, Philadelphia County, is designated as the 65th Infantry
- 15 "Boringueneers" Avenue.
- 16 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 17 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 18 traffic in both directions.
- 19 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
