AN ACT

- Designating a portion of PA Route 191 in Washington Township,
 Northampton County, as the "World War II Homefront Heroes
- 3 Highway."
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. World War II Homefront Heroes Highway.
- 7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) The dedication of the American people during World
- 10 War II was crucial in supplying and aiding both American and
- 11 Allied forces engaged in battle on two global theaters.
- 12 (2) The American citizens at home sacrificed by
- 13 rationing materials, recycling goods, purchasing War Bonds,
- and tirelessly working longer hours in factories, mines,
- 15 mills, farms and many other industries to keep the war effort

- 1 moving forward.
- 2 (3) With many young men serving in the armed forces,
- 3 American women were quick to step up and take jobs in
- 4 industries that were considered reserved for men only, and
- 5 subsequently made "Rosie the Riveter" a popular, and now
- 6 classic, American icon.
- 7 (4) Civilian support for the armed forces and defense of
- 8 the nation spurred the establishment of numerous groups and
- 9 organizations such as the Civil Air Patrol, Coast Guard
- 10 Auxiliary and United Service Organizations (USO), which exist
- 11 to this day.
- 12 (5) Through their steadfast dedication and support,
- 13 United States citizens at home were able to keep American and
- 14 Allied forces supplied with materials and morale, which was
- instrumental in achieving victory and ending one of the
- deadliest wars in the history of human existence.
- 17 (b) Designation. -- That portion of PA Route 191 in Washington
- 18 Township, Northampton County, from the Bangor Borough line to
- 19 the Plainfield Township line is hereby designated as the "World
- 20 War II Homefront Heroes Highway."
- 21 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 22 maintain signs to traffic in both directions to indicate the
- 23 designation under subsection (b).
- 24 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
