AN ACT

1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for establishment of State Gaming
3 Fund and net slot machine revenue distribution.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1403(c)(2)(iii)(A) of Title 4 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1403. Establishment of State Gaming Fund and net slot machine
9 revenue distribution.

11 (c) Transfers and distributions.--The department shall:

12 * * *

13 (2) From the local share assessment established in
14 subsection (b), make quarterly distributions among the
15 counties hosting a licensed facility in accordance with the
16 following schedule:

18 (iii) If the facility is a Category 2 licensed

1 facility and if the county in which the licensed facility
2 is located is:

3 (A) A county of the first class: 4% of the
4 gross terminal revenue to the county hosting the
5 licensed facility from each such licensed facility.
6 The total amount distributed annually to the county
7 of the first class under this part shall be
8 distributed to the Philadelphia School District.

9 Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
10 funds from licensed gaming entities located within a
11 county of the first class shall not be distributed
12 outside of a county of the first class. [The first
13 \$5,000,000 of the total amount distributed annually
14 to the county of the first class shall be distributed
15 to the Philadelphia School District.]

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
