AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled, as
 2 reenacted, "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and
 3 malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating
 4 and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and
 5 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession,
 6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding
 7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic
 8 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the
 9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and
 10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing
 11 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores,
 12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective
 13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain
 14 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure
 15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures;
 16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in
 17 licenses and regulations, liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed
 18 beverages, further providing for unlawful acts relative to
 19 malt or brewed beverages or licensees.

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 21 hereby enacts as follows:

22 Section 1. Section 492 of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90,
 23 No.21), known as the Liquor Code, reenacted and amended June 29,
 24 1987 (P.L.32, No.14), is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

25 Section 492. Unlawful Acts Relative to Malt or Brewed
 26 Beverages and Licensees.--

1 It shall be unlawful--

2 * * *

3 (22) Manufacturers Requiring Payment in Exchange for
4 Territorial Rights. For any manufacturer to require or accept
5 payment in exchange for an agreement setting forth territorial
6 rights as required under section 431.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
