AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for Commonwealth secondary 5 school diploma. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 section to read: Section 1613.1. Commonwealth Secondary School Diploma. -- (a) 12 13 Within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this section, the Department of Education shall solicit proposals for the 14 15 establishment and implementation of at least two testing-16 programs ONE COMPUTER-BASED HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT 17 AND AT LEAST ONE PAPER-BASED HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT 18 under which individuals who do not possess a secondary school

diploma and are not enrolled in a public or nonpublic school may

- 1 <u>obtain a Commonwealth secondary school diploma upon earning a</u>
- 2 passing score as determined by the Department of Education. The
- 3 Department of Education shall at a minimum publish notice of its
- 4 intention to solicit proposals in the Pennsylvania Bulletin and
- 5 on its publicly accessible Internet website.
- 6 (b) Within one year of the effective date of this section,
- 7 the Department of Education shall establish, implement and
- 8 maintain at least two testing programs ONE COMPUTER-BASED HIGH <--
- 9 <u>SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT AND AT LEAST ONE PAPER-BASED HIGH</u>
- 10 SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT under which individuals may obtain
- 11 <u>a Commonwealth secondary school diploma.</u>
- 12 (c) Each testing program HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT <--
- 13 <u>established under subsection (b) shall:</u>
- 14 (1) be aligned with the rigor of Pennsylvania academic
- 15 <u>standards; AND</u>
- 16 <u>(2) be available in both a paper based and computer based</u> <--

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- 17 testing format; and
- 18 (3) include multiple testing sections that may be taken <--
- 19 on separate dates.
- 20 (d) In establishing testing programs EACH HIGH SCHOOL <--
- 21 EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT pursuant to subsection (b), the
- 22 Department of Education shall consider the affordability and
- 23 accessibility of testing programs EACH HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY <--
- 24 ASSESSMENT to maximize the ability of individuals to obtain a
- 25 <u>Commonwealth secondary school diploma.</u>
- 26 (E) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL HAVE <--
- 27 THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION:
- 28 "COMMONWEALTH SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA" MEANS THE HIGH SCHOOL
- 29 EOUIVALENCY CREDENTIAL ISSUED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF
- 30 PENNSYLVANIA TO RESIDENTS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH WHO DO NOT

- 1 POSSESS A SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA.
- 2 "HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT" MEANS AN ASSESSMENT
- 3 <u>DESIGNED TO CERTIFY THAT AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS NOT GRADUATED</u>
- 4 FROM HIGH SCHOOL HAS OBTAINED A HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL OF ACADEMIC
- 5 SKILL.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
